

Connect Game Consoles to the TCU Network

Game Consoles such as Wii, Xbox, Xbox 360, PS2 and PS3 can be connected to the TCU Student Network.

Find the network (MAC/Ethernet) address of your device

- Addresses can usually be found the system settings of the device. Use a printed manual or online manual to find instructions.
- Click [here](#) for a link to helpful instructions for game consoles
- Find the address and write it down for future use

Register the network (MAC/Ethernet) address

- On a computer with an Internet connection, login to <http://my.tcu.edu> using your TCU **username** and **password**
- Select the **TCU Network Registration** icon from the home page
- Read the TCU Computing Resources Policy and click **Accept** to continue
- On the TCU Network Registration page, click **Insert New Address**

- Under ***Subnet**, choose **Student-Wired**
For ***Computer Type**, select **Game Console**
- In the **Ethernet Address**, type in the network address of your game console
- Underneath ***My Description**, enter a small description of the registration for future reference, i.e. "SuperFrog's Xbox."
- Click **Save**. Your device has been registered for the TCU Network!

Restart your game console

- Unplug the Ethernet network cord from the game console. Power off and back on the game console, then connect the Ethernet network cord to your game console and to the network wall jack.
